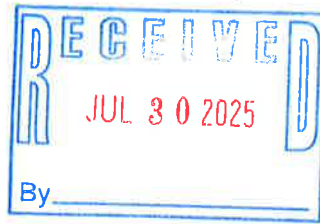

**Re: Movement of Speed Bumps on Court Street**

Please accept this letter for what it is... an angry complaint. As a resident of Cherry Avenue, I am extremely upset about the relocation of one of the speed bumps being placed immediately south of Lafayette Street on Court Street. Where was the notice to and input from the residents who are truly impacted by this unnecessary change.

The speed bumps on Court Street were originally approved to slow traffic in the area of the Village playground. This new placement has no bearing on the playground and does not allow residents of this area to avoid them. If Cherry Avenue is to remain one way, a decision made after the speed bumps were added to the north end of Court Street, there is no way around them.
